

# Rotary Club of St. Petersburg GRANT APPLICATION INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

### Grants will not be awarded for the following:

- Annual campaigns
- General operating costs
- Building or endowment funds
- Loans
- Emergency funds
- Land acquisition
- Deficit financing
- Individuals
- Tickets or event sponsorships
- Legislative lobbying or political campaigns
- Religious or sectarian purposes

#### **Eligibility guidelines:**

- Applying organization must be a tax-exempt 501(c)3 status.
- Applying organization must file a Form 990.
- 70% of organization's revenues must be allocated to Program Expense as noted on Form 990.
- Members of the organization's Board of Directors must not be employees of the organization.
- Organization must be headquartered south of Ulmerton Road in Pinellas County, FL or be approved Rotary International projects.
- Grants will be awarded to a specific program or project.
- Priority projects are those of Rotary International: Child and maternal health, hunger, literacy, clean water, promoting peace and conflict resolution and services/leadership development of youth.

Applications will be accepted beginning March 1, 2021.

Applications must be received in the Rotary office by 12:00 p.m., April 1, 2021 to be eligible for consideration in the 2021 funding cycle.
